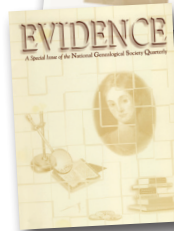
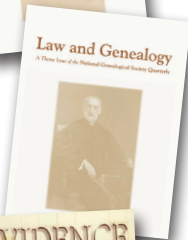
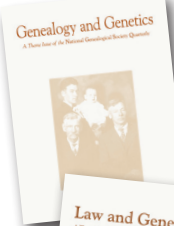
## NGS Magazine

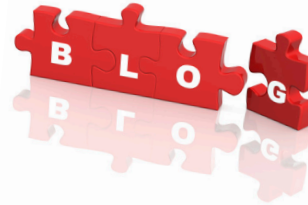
## NGS Quarterly
