

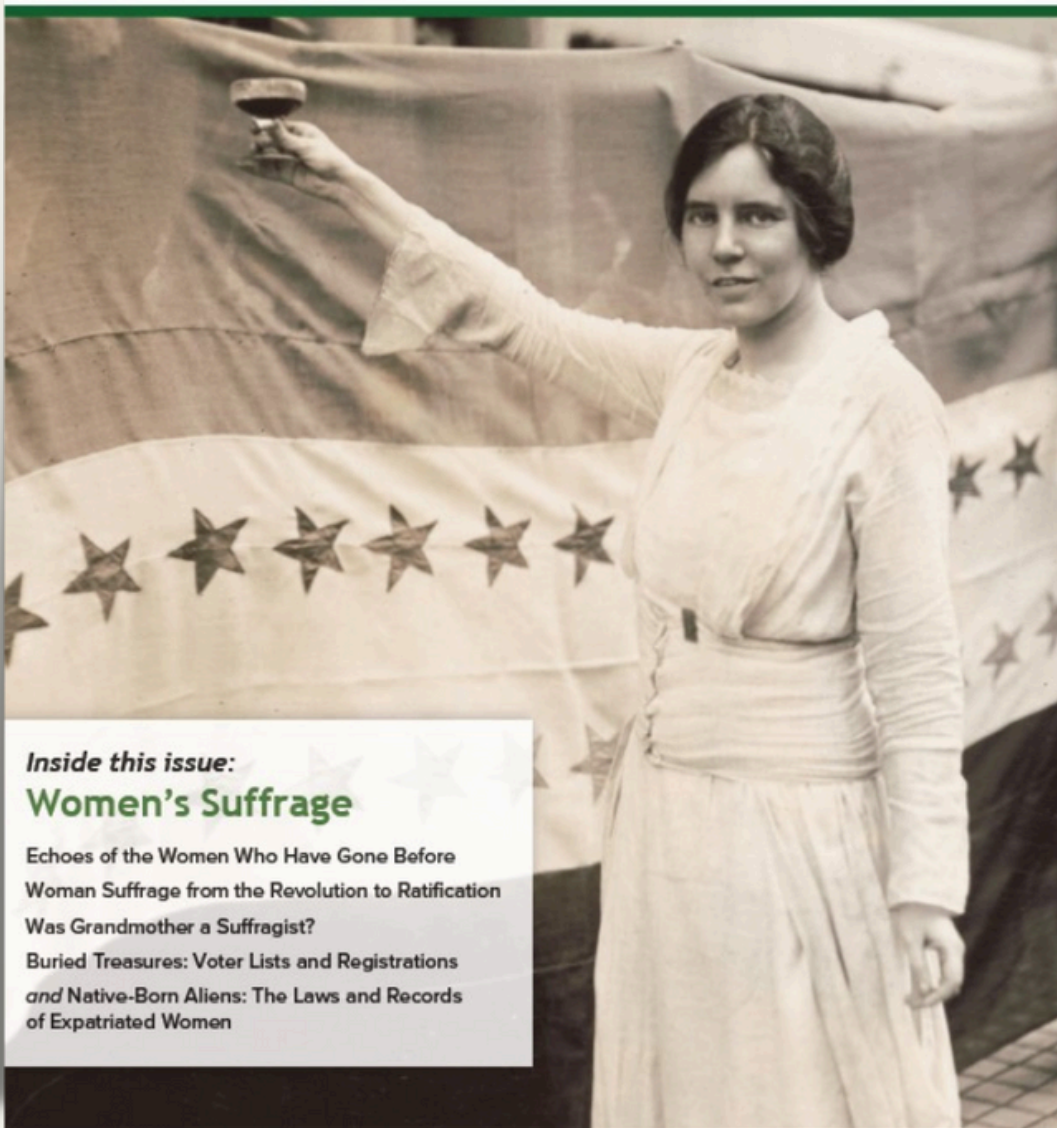

The **NGS Magazine** article index is a searchable PDF file organized in reverse chronological order. To locate authors' names or specific keywords within titles, use the Find feature in the edit menu on a PC or Mac, or use the command keys Ctrl+F. The text of the articles is not searchable in this index.

The index includes all features, columns, tributes, and NGS conference articles with repository information published in **NGS Magazine** between 2005 and 2024. It does not include NGS announcements, volunteer and donor lists, awards, nominations, book notices, or software reviews. Find those items by checking the table of contents of individual issues. The article index will be updated annually.

NGS Magazine began as the **NGS Newsletter** in 1975. It became **NGS News Magazine** in 2000, and the title was shortened to **NGS Magazine** in 2008. All issues from 2005 to date have been digitized in the archive (<https://www.ngsgenealogy.org/magazine/archives>) and are available only to NGS members. Issues before 2005 are not in the archive but are held in many libraries.
